WHERE:	UNH, Whittemore Center, 128 Main St, Durham, NH (1 hour north of Boston)
ELIGIBILITY:	Anyone currently registered with any of the national governing bodies USJA, USJF, or USA Judo may enter the tournament. <u>Cards MUST be presented at registration or a copy included with pre-</u> <u>registration</u> . Applications will be available during registration, payment by check or credit card only.
RULES:	<u>True Double Elimination</u> . Modified IJF rules including: pre-2003 medical, 2010 ashi-dori penalty shall be <u>shido</u> when blatant, in Golden Score (10 min. limit) original match scores will remain. No shime-waza in yonen. No kansetsu-waza in yonen or shonen. In senior divisions if contestant(s) below sankyu, no kansetsu unless agreed upon by both players/coaches. Ne waza division permits armlocks for all ranks and follows standard judo rules with scoring TBA. White competitor must wear white gi, no blue belt. Blue competitor may wear either color judogi. Any additional modifications decided by tournament director and head referee subject to tournament day conditions.
MATCH TIME:	Ne waza division – 3 minutes (no golden score) Juniors up to 7-8 years – 2 minutes All other junior, senior novice and masters divisions – 3 minutes Senior men's advanced – 5 minutes / Senior women's divisions [*] – 4 minutes
REGISTRATION & WEIGH-IN:	8:00 to 9:30am, junior & masters divisions, <u>registration will close promptly at 9:30 am!</u> 10:00 to 11:00am, senior divisions Late arrivals may be refused entry, please plan accordingly. Early weigh-ins will be permitted for those who have pre-registered from 7 – 9pm on Friday
COMPETITION SCHEDULE:	Juniors, Ne Waza, & Masters: 10:00am Seniors immediately follow Junior/Ne Waza/Masters, no earlier than 11:30am
ENTRY FEE:	Pre-registration entry fee of \$30 postmarked by February 15 th with check enclosed. If included with pre-registration, 2 nd div. fee: \$15. Late (or walk-up) entry / late 2 nd division fees: \$40 / \$20. Online registration at <u>www.unh.edu/judo-club</u> with pre-registration rates until Feb. 15 th , late rates until Feb. 19 th . Early-bird discount of \$5 per division when pre-registered online by February 8 th !

- **AWARDS:** Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers in all contested divisions **1st place in Sr. Women's / Sr. Men's Advanced will receive \$100 cash prize if division contains at least 6 competitors. Limit one cash prize per competitor.
- **MATS:** There will be three contest areas running throughout the day at this event.
- **REFEREES:** Head National Referee: Ken Durand. Referees, side-judges, match-setters, time- and scorekeepers are needed and experienced volunteers are greatly appreciated. Referees shall receive a stipend according to certification level: National & higher \$50, all others \$25. Please confirm at least 1 week before tournament day to allow time for check to be drawn.

DIRECTIONS:

From Route 95 N/S:	Take exit 4 (on 95 North) or 5 (on 95 South) onto Route
	16 North, Spaulding Turnpike. Take exit 6W (Route 4 West) heading toward Concord. After passing the exit
	for Route 108, there will be a traffic light at Madbury
	Rd. Take a left onto Madbury Rd, then right onto
	Edgewood Road. On the corner of Edgewood and Main
	St is the Whittemore Center.

- From Route 101: Take exit 7 onto Route 125 and head north. Take the first right onto Route 4 East at the traffic circle in Lee. At the traffic light, take a right onto Madbury Rd, then another right onto Edgewood Road. On the corner of Edgewood and Main St. is the Whittemore Center.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE (Including Limited Co-Ed Competition for Age 10 and Under for USJA Sanction)

In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way, including travel to and from, in any Judo tournament, practice, clinic, and related events and activities ("Activity") of the United States Judo Association, United States Judo Federation, Inc., USA Judo/United States Judo, Inc., New Hampshire Judo Inc., University of New Hampshire, and University of New Hampshire Judo Club, I agree

1. I understand the nature of Judo activities and believe I am qualified to participate in such Activity. I also understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.

2. I further acknowledge that prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions, and the elimination or scoring system to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or a tournament official of such conditions and refuse to participate.

3. I acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, illness or disease, including permanent disability or death, and severe social and economic losses due not only to my own actions, inactions or negligence, but also to the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules of the sport of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known to me or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.

4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, illness, disease, permanent disability, or death.

5. I hereby release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the United States Judo Association, Inc., United States Judo Federation, Inc., USA Judo/United States Judo, Inc., New Hampshire Judo Inc., University of New Hampshire, and University of New Hampshire Judo Club, together with their affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, agents, coaches, and other employees or volunteers of the

organization, event officials, medical personnel, other participants, their parents, guardians, supervisors and coaches, sponsoring agencies, sponsor advertisers, and if applicable, owners, lessors and lessees of premises used in conducting the event, all of whom are hereinafter referred to as "Releasees", from any and all litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage or costs on account of injury, illness, disease, including permanent disability and death or damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Releasees or otherwise to the fullest extent permitted by law.
