WHERE: UNH, Whittemore Center, 128 Main St, Durham, NH (1 hour north of Boston)

ELIGIBILITY: Anyone currently registered with any of the national governing bodies USJA, USJF, or USA Judo

may enter the tournament. <u>Cards MUST be presented at registration or a copy included with pre-registration</u>. Applications will be available during registration, payment by check or credit card only.

RULES: Round robin for divisions of 3 & 4, true double elimination for all others. Modified IJF rules

including: pre-2003 medical; ashi-dori will be shido for yonen, <u>hansoku make for all others</u>; no shime-waza in yonen; no kansetsu-waza yonen/shonen/senior novice, in senior advanced/ne waza armlocks permitted regardless of competitors' ranks. Ne waza follows standard judo rules/scoring TBA. White competitor **must** wear white gi. Blue competitor may wear blue/white. Any additional modifications decided by tournament director and head referee subject to tournament day conditions.

MATCH TIME: Ne waza division – 3 minutes / no golden score

Juniors 5-8 – 2 minutes / 2 minute golden score Juniors 9-12 – 2 minutes / 2 minute golden score

Juniors 13-16, senior novice and masters divisions – 3 minutes / 10 min golden score

Senior men's advanced – 5 minutes / Senior women's divisions* – 4 minutes / 10 min golden score

REGISTRATION 8:00 to 9:30am, junior & masters divisions, registration will close promptly at 9:30 am!

& WEIGH-IN: 10:00 to 11:00am, senior divisions

Late arrivals may be refused entry, please plan accordingly.

Early weigh-ins will be permitted for those who have pre-registered from 7 – 9pm on Friday 3/4

COMPETITION Juniors, Ne Waza, & Masters: 10:00am

SCHEDULE: Seniors immediately follow Junior/Ne Waza/Masters, no earlier than 11:30am

ENTRY FEE: Pre-registration entry fee of \$30 postmarked by February 27th with check enclosed. If included with

pre-registration, 2nd div. fee: \$15. Late (or walk-up) entry / late 2nd division fees: \$40 / \$20.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE (Including Limited Co-Ed Competition for Age 10 and Under for USJA Sanction)

In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way, including travel to and from, in any Judo tournament, practice, clinic, and related events and activities ("Activity") of the United States Judo Association, United States Judo Federation, Inc., USA Judo/United States Judo, Inc., New Hampshire Judo Inc., University of New Hampshire, and University of New Hampshire Judo Club, I agree

- 1. I understand the nature of Judo activities and believe I am qualified to participate in such Activity. I also understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.
- 2. I further acknowledge that prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions, and the elimination or scoring system to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or a tournament official of such conditions and refuse to participate.
- 3. I acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, illness or disease, including permanent disability or death, and severe social and economic losses due not only to my own actions, inactions or negligence, but also to the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules of the sport of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known to me or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
- 4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, illness, disease, permanent disability, or death.
- 5. I hereby release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the United States Judo Association, Inc., United States Judo Federation, Inc., USA Judo/United States Judo, Inc., New Hampshire Judo Inc., University of New Hampshire, and University of New Hampshire Judo Club, together with their affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, directors, agents, coaches, and other employees or volunteers of the organization, event officials, medical personnel, other participants, their parents, guardians, supervisors and coaches, sponsoring agencies, sponsor advertisers, and if applicable, owners, lessors and lessees of premises used in conducting the event, all of whom are hereinafter referred to as "Releasees", from any and all litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage or costs on account of injury, illness, disease, including permanent disability and death or damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Releasees or otherwise to the fullest extent permitted by law.
